5th ANNUAL EXPO RETURNS TO ST. PETERSBURG'S COLISEUM

ST. PETERSBURG (May 14, 2010) - **The Tampa Bay Living Green Expo** - formerly the Pinellas Living Green Expo - returns to St. Petersburg's historic Coliseum and adjacent Mirror Lake Complex for a weekend loaded with ideas and solutions on how to save money and the environment. The popular event, now in its 5th year, is **free** and will be open to the public on Saturday June 5th and Sunday June 6th.

The list of exhibitors and vendors has grown to more than 120 and with more than 40 seminars being offered, **Tampa Bay Living Green Expo** guests will be able to learn about the most cost effective and environmentally responsible methods of creating a more sustainable way of living here on Florida's West Coast.

New this year, in partnership with the Urban League, a Green Jobs Fair will take place at the Expo. The theme of the **Tampa Bay Living Green Expo** is "Save Money... Save the Environment". In these uncertain economic times, it has never been more important to make sure we are preserving our dwindling natural resources and moving our society towards sustainability, and local employers realize this. Our new green economy will require workers ready for the tasks necessary for the evolving job climate.

Expo visitors will be able to view 15 science fair projects from area high school students focused on the fields of solar cells, bio-fuels, and energy conservation. Also on display will be art made entirely of recycled materials or addressing a sustainability issue, as part of a juried art show for Pinellas County students.

The **Tampa Bay Living Green Expo** will be open from 9am - 5pm on Saturday and from 10am - 4pm on Sunday. The Coliseum is located 535 5th Ave. N, at the end of I-375 in downtown St. Petersburg. Admission and parking are both free! Come spend the day with us.
